CAPT McNeal is currently serving as commodore, FIFTH Naval Expeditionary Logistics Regiment, Point Hueneme, Ca. In his civilian career, McNeal is the Managing Recruiter of International Search Partners, an Executive Search firm based in La Mesa, Ca.

CAPT McNeal graduated from the United States Naval Academy with a Bachelor of Science in 1986 and holds a Master's of Science in Organizational Management from Chadron State College. He also graduated from the Advanced Joint Professional Military Education program at the Joint Forces Staff College and is JQS Level II qualified.

CAPT McNeal's afloat assignments include Disbursing Officer and Wardroom Officer, USS CONSTELLATION (CV 64); and Assistant Supply Officer, USS MERRILL (DD 976).

His staff assignments include Assistant Chief of Staff for Operations, Defense Logistics Agency (J-9); Operations Officer, FISC San Diego Detachment 519; Training Officer, Naval Special Warfare Command; Division Officer, Naval Regional Contracting Command 519; and Supply Officer, Submarine Base, San Diego.

#### **ROBERT O'LEAR '55**

Robert was born on May 24, 1931 in Yonkers, New York. He attended the U.S. Naval Academy by congressional appointment and graduated in June of 1955. After graduation he served as an officer in the United States Air Force. He resigned his commission and pursued a career as an Electronic Engineer. He earned a masters degree in civil engineering from Columbia University.

Robert met his wife, Tulia in New York. They moved to San Diego in 1969 and he worked for Naval Ocean System Center before retiring in 1989.

Robert was a member of St. Therese Church since 1970. In his 42 years as a parishioner he was a member of the Knights of Columbus and was a Eucharistic Minister. He had a deep passion for people in crisis and spent thousands of hours volunteering with the Family Crisis hotline, suicide hotline, and also visited prisoners serving life in jail. In his spare time he loved golfing with his wife and traveling.

He died February 12, 2013. He was 81 years old at the time of his death. His family was with him during his illness and at his death. He is survived by his wife and extended family.
