#### PRESIDENT'S LETTER

Dear Fellow Alumni & Friends of USNA,

USNA and Annapolis, MD are thawing out after a very cold-snowy winter and are anxiously waiting for spring weather to return to the banks of the Severn River. This past month was busy at the academy with Capt Robert E. Clarke II, '84, USN selected as the 84<sup>th</sup> Commandant of Midshipmen replacing RDML (Sel) Matt Klunder '82, USN. The CNO, Adm Gary Roughead '73, USN, also announced that Female Midshipmen from the USNA Class of 2011 would be the first women to serve on submarines when approved by Congress.

Our March 18<sup>th</sup> Chapter luncheon speaker at Tom Ham's was Capt Mark Cedrum '84, USN, Deputy Commander Expeditionary Strike Group-Three. Mark provided a very engaging and informative brief of his deployment to 5<sup>th</sup> Fleet as Commanding Officer aboard USS Boxer (LHD-4). USS Boxer hosted CTF-151 in performing 5<sup>th</sup> Fleet Operations engaged in Anti-Piracy missions. Mark and his crew played a pivotal role in the successful rescue of Capt Richard Phillips from the container ship MAERSK ALABAMA. Thank you Mark for providing our Chapter an outstanding brief and overview of your deployment!

A Chapter Board meeting was held March 16<sup>th</sup> in which several key initiatives were discussed and approved. The Board approved:

1) Moving our Web Hosting to the commercial provider BlueHost. We also approved transitioning our email services to Constant Contact. These two IT upgrades will move our Chapter ahead light years in our IT capability.

2) The recommendation to move our monthly luncheons to the Navy Anchors Club at 32<sup>nd</sup> St, effective for our April 15<sup>th</sup> luncheon. This decision was not made lightly, but we needed to make the move in order to contain costs for our Chapter members.

3) Dave Frost '75 will be stepping down as our VP for Membership. In his place, the Board approved Rich Carlquist '80 to be Dave's replacement

Thanks to Dave for all the great work he did for our Chapter as VP of Membership.

Diana Edmondson '98, provided a thorough review of Chapter finances. I am happy to report our Chapter finances are healthy with \$6,796.63 in checking and \$8,370.18 in savings as of 12/31/09.

### Last Call:

#### COL John R. Love, USMC '51

John Reily Love died March 5. He was born in Memphis, TN and grew up in AZ.

2<sup>nd</sup> LT Love participated in the 1952 Korean Spring and Summer Campaigns. After his Korean War service, he was stationed at the Marine Barracks, in Wash, DC. He served as Aide-de-Camp to the Asst Commandant.

In 1967, Lt. Col. Love was ordered to Vietnam where he commanded the 2nd BN, 7th Marines until 1968 when he was assigned as Executive Officer of the Regiment. In 1971, he transferred to Camp Pendleton as the CO, Headquarters BN.

In 1977, he was ordered to the Army War College, Carlisle, PA as the Marine Corps Representative and faculty member where he remained until his retirement in 1981.

Upon retirement, Col Love settled in Portsmouth, NH. He was Operations Manager for the Vinnell Corporation in Saudi Arabia until 1985 and he then devoted his time to serving as an Adjunct Faculty Professor for four New England colleges.

He moved to Carlsbad, CA in 1995 where he lived until his death. He is survived by daughter Kristin, son Scott, granddaughter Melanie, all of Seattle, WA, and his companion Marjorie Peterson of Carlsbad, CA. He was predeceased by his wife, Beverly.

### CDR Daryl Foley, USN, '55

Daryl Foley died on 16 Feb; he was 78 years old. Daryl graduated from Coronado High, enlisted in the Navy and was awarded a Presidential appointment to USNA from the Fleet, graduating with the Class of 1955.

CDR Foley's was an aviator with 30 years on duty in Pensacola, San Diego, St. Louis, Saigon and Guam. He served one year on ADM Zumwalt's staff in Saigon and two years as XO NAS Agana Guam. Among his awards were: Air Medal, Navy Commendation Medal, Navy Achievement Medal and several Vietnam service medals.

CDR Foley is survived by his former wife, Marcia; and his girlfriend, Debra, as well as children Patrick, Timothy, Colleen, Eileen, Kevin, and Maureen and 14 grandchildren. He was predeceased by one daughter, Darlene.

A Memorial Service was held for Daryl Foley at Fort Rosecrans National Cemetery on 15 March 2010. The Class of 1955 was represented by Roger Coffey, Ned Floyd, and Smoke & Connie Wilson. Afterward, family and friends of Daryl gathered at Pt. Loma Seafood Restaurant for a final tribute.

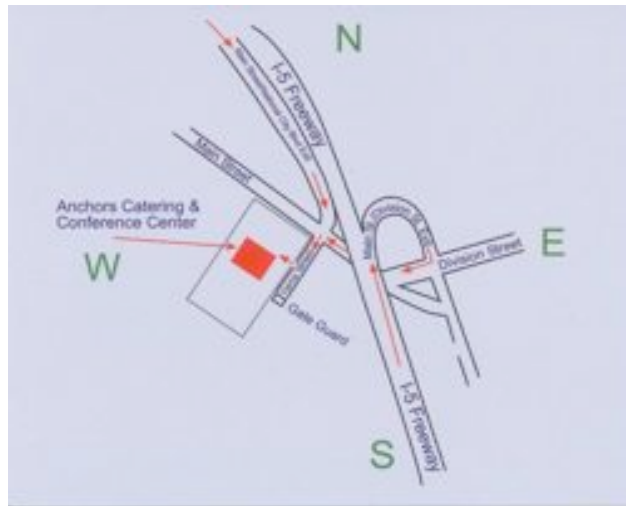
