If you missed the Jul luncheon, you missed a very lively and engaging pair of speakers. CAPT John Funk '84 and CMDCM Tae Harris, the Executive Assistant and Command Master Chief for Cdr SPAWAR led an open and frank dialog about the Navy's implementation of the repeal of Don't Ask, Don't Tell. It was especially timely as the President signed the legislation marking the end of Don't Ask, Don't Tell the following day. CAPT Funk and CMDCM Harris told us how the training was accomplished across the Navy and how the policy will be adopted. For those of us who are old enough to remember other memorable policy changes like the integration of minorities and women, this is just another stepping stone in allowing the Navy to use the talents of all service men and women.

As a reminder, we will not be having our traditional luncheon at Anchors in Aug. Instead we will have our annual field trip. This year Bill Personius '80 has arranged for us to visit the Littoral Combat Ship (LCS) Shore Based Trainer (SBT). This hands-on simulator prepares our sailors for duty onboard the LCS. Last Call

CDR Daniel F. GLEVY USN (Ret) '64



Cdr Daniel Glevy passed away in San Diego on 12 Jul. CDR Glevy was born in Newark, New Jersey on Sep 15, 1940. He had been a resident of San Diego since retiring from the Navy in 1988.

He graduated from USNA with the Class of 1964 and was selected for flight training as a Naval Flight Officer (NFO). He served his country as a navigational officer in the RA5C Vigilante reconnaissance plane and as an oceanographic specialist.

After earning his NFO wings at Pensacola, CDR Glevy was assigned to fly RA5C Vigilante Photo Recon aircraft with RVAH-9 out of Sanford, FL. He flew 64 combat missions over North Vietnam from USS RANGER (CV-61), followed by Cold War recon missions in the Mediterranean Sea

from USS SARATOGA (CV-60). A shore assignment as a Company/Battalion Officer at Aviation Officer Schools Command preceded another sea assignment aboard USS JOHN F. KENNEDY (CV-67). He then made a career change to Meteorology Oceanography Specialist. Postgraduate studies in Meteorology at the Naval Post-Graduate School in Monterrey CA, earned him a Masters degree in Meteorology and he served as a Meteorologist in several tours in NavMetOceanCom activities in San Diego and Hawaii including sea duty aboard USS RANGER eventually settling in San Diego at ASW School Pacific where he retired from the Navy in 1988.

During Cdr Glevy's 24-year naval career, he earned many awards which recognized his distinguished service to his country. He was decorated with the Distinguished Flying Cross, five Air Medals, the Navy Commendation Medal, the Navy Unit Commendation, the Navy Meritorious Unit Commendation, the American Defense Service Medal, the Vietnam Service Medal and the Vietnamese Gallantry Cross Citation.

In his retirement years, Cdr Glevy coached youth soccer and Little League baseball and volunteered as a baseball umpire.

He is survived by his wife, Patricia Glevy, his two sons, Michael and Daniel Patrick Glevy, and Patricia's children Don, Dave, Dana, Darryl, Doug, Doryce, and Daython Garcia, as well as Darla Adams and Danylle Ennnis. He was predeceased in 1998 by his wife of 34 years, Linda M. Glevy,

whom he described in his 40th Reunion book as "a great Navy wife". He remarried in 2003.

In lieu of flowers, the family requests donations be made in his name to the Vietnam Veterans of America.
