Sept Luncheon

This is one presentation you don't want to miss. Captain Dan Eagan, USMC, '04 was our host for our tour of MCRD. He serves as Executive Officer, Company L, 3rd Recruit Training Battalion, MCRD San Diego. He and his Drill Instructors take America's youth and turn them into Marines in just twelve weeks. For those of us who haven't seen the product coming in the door compared to the fine young Marines on graduation day, it is a process which produces excellent results. During our tour of MCRD Dan just scratched the surface on what it takes to become a Marine in today's environment, so we have asked him to join us for lunch and tell us more. In addition, Dan had an interesting experience serving along the Iraq / Syria border and is fluent in Farsi. We asked Dan to tell us about how he learned to speak Farsi, what a difference it made for him in country and how his mission along the border was different from some of the other military who have served in the middle east and have spoken to us recently.

Captain Eagan was commissioned a Second Lieutenant in the Marine Corps in May 2004, having completed his undergraduate education in History at the U.S. Naval Academy.

Following Basic School and the Logistics Officer Course, he was assigned to Combat Logistics Battalion 1, Combat Logistics Regiment 1, 1st Marine Logistics Group. During this tour, Captain Eagan served as a Motor Transport Platoon Commander before receiving orders to Combat Logistics Battalion 15, 15th Marine Expeditionary Unit. During his tour with Combat Logistics Battalion 15, Captain Eagan served as the Battalion Assistant Operations Officer, and participated in various exercises and a unit deployment to the Western Pacific and Iraq. Upon completion of his deployment in Iraq, Captain Eagan returned to Combat Logistics Regiment 1 where he served as the Regimental Training Officer and as the Regimental Liaison Officer to 1st Marine Division.

In October 2007, Captain Eagan was transferred to the I MEF Advisory Training Group and began preparations for a deployment as part of a Border Transition Team. During his assignment to the team, Captain Eagan served concurrently as the team's Logistics Officer and Intelligence Officer while operating in an extremely remote location along the Iraq-Syria border. Upon completion of his deployment to Iraq, Captain Eagan received orders to the Marine Corps Recruit Depot in San Diego, California.

Captain Eagan served as the Follow Series Commander for Company L, 3rd Recruit Training Battalion for three training cycles and graduated over four hundred new Marines during that time. On 11 September 2009 Capt Eagan took over as the Company Executive Officer for Company L.

Captain Eagan's personal decorations include the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal and the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal.

CAPT William B. Anderson Jr. SC USN RET '49

Captain William B. ANDERSON Jr., SC USN (Ret) passed away August 15, 2009.

A native of West Branch, Iowa, he was born on September 21, 1925, to William B. and Dorothy Anderson. He graduated from West Branch High School and attended the University of Iowa and Northwestern University before receiving his commission to the U.S. Naval Academy in 1945.

After graduating from the Naval Academy in 1949, he spent 28 years on active duty in the U.S. Navy Supply Corps with multiple tours in California, Japan, Virginia, Pennsylvania and Hawaii. While in the Supply Corps, he attained his MBA from Stanford University in 1959.

Andy's last move on active duty with the U.S. Navy was to San Diego, CA, where he served as Commanding Officer of the Naval Supply Center. He retired in Rancho Bernardo, CA, with his wife, Hanna. After retiring, Andy was actively involved in several civic organizations including the Kiwanis Club, the YMCA, and the National Football Foundation. He also served as a trustee of the Herbert Hoover Library Foundation in West Branch, Iowa. Andy loved playing golf and was often on the course in his retirement years.

He is survived by his wife of 52 years, the former Hanna Cuddy of Philadelphia, PA; son Bill "Trip"; daughter, Jona Bolin; and grandchildren, Amanda, Chris and Morgan.
