Obituaries

CDR William J. Sturgeon III, USN (Ret) '53

Bill was born in Chicago in 1928 and passed away on Aug. 18, 2015 at his home in Coronado.

In his young years, he moved frequently from Indiana, Florida, Tennessee, Georgia and Alabama before receiving an appointment, through the fleet, to the U.S. Naval Academy in Annapolis, Md. Bill earned a bachelor's degree and graduated from the Academy in 1953. Shortly after graduation, he received orders to report to Pensacola, FL, to commence flight training. He earned his naval aviator "Wings of Gold" in February, 1955.

In 1958 he married Barbara Curtis, in her hometown of Needham, MA. The next year they reported back to the U.S. Naval Academy where Bill taught the Russian language for three years. He served in various squadrons on both the East and West Coast, making eight deployments on aircraft carriers including three tours to Vietnam. He retired as chief of staff of the Nuclear Weapons Training Group, at North Island Naval Air Station in Coronado. After retirement from the Navy, Bill specialized in office and network information management systems at a major manufacturing firm in San Diego.

Bill was a proud and dedicated member of the Rotary Club of Coronado since 1978. He served on the board of directors, as secretary, twice as international chair and club president in 1998-1999, as well as serving on several committees. He also served at the district level on the GSE Committee, Ambassadorial Scholar Committee as a Rotary Youth Leadership Academy (RYLA) facilitator, five years as the chairman of the District Rotary Youth Exchange Program and as District 5340 Governor from 2001 to 2002. In 1990, he participated in the installation of the first Rotary Club in Leningrad, Russia, (since renamed St. Petersburg).

He founded the only Rotary summer youth camp in the United States in 1997. This allowed students from the San Diego district to be invited to attend any of the 85 similar Rotary summer camps conducted annually throughout Europe and the Near East. Since 1996, he had served on the Board of SCANEX, a multi-district organization that fosters and administers youth exchange. In 2005, Bill also conceived the idea of extending summer youth exchange to a music camp in which youngsters from dozens of countries would come to San Diego and play with the San Diego Youth Symphony, a program which continues today.

Bill is preceded in death by his brother Robert Sturgeon. He is survived by his beloved wife of 56 years, Barbara; his son William J. Sturgeon IV and his wife Jessica of Fort Lauderdale, FL; his daughter Sharon Sturgeon and grandson Robbie Araiza of Austin, Texas; his sister Nancy Carpenter and her husband Jim of Amelia Island, FL and four nephews.
