Obituaries

CAPT Edward S. (Ned) Kellogg III USN (Ret) '54

Edward S. 'Ned' Kellogg III, died on September 2, 2013, at the age of 80. He was born on February 13, 1933, the only son of Edward and Dorothy Kellogg of Glendale, California. At the time of his death, he was a resident of Casa de las Campanas in Rancho Bernardo, California.

A 1954 graduate of the United States Naval Academy, he served his country with distinction for 30 years, retiring as a Captain in 1984. His Naval career included the command of *USS Narwhal* (SSN-671) and *USS Fulton* (AS-11). He served as Chief of Staff, Submarine Group 5 here in San Diego, Reactor Officer on *USS Enterprise* (CVAN-65), and Commanding Officer, Naval Station Mare Island.

Following retirement from the Navy, Ned embarked on his second career in the Episcopal Diocese of San Diego. Reverend Ned was an ordained Episcopal deacon, then priest. As in his career in the Navy, he served the Church with great dedication and enthusiasm. He served parish communities of the Cathedral of St. Paul, downtown San Diego, University City, Poway, Lake Elsinore, Escondido, San Carlos, El Cajon, and Lemon Grove. A longtime member of All Souls Episcopal Church in Point Loma, he was an active leader in both the San Diego and National Episcopal Cursillo. He was also a volunteer Chaplain at Sharp Memorial Hospital for 23 years. Upon his retirement from the ministry, he was pastoral assistant to the Bishop of San Diego.

Ned is survived by his wife, Margaret (Wagner) of Los Angeles. Married for 59 years, they made their home in many states: Hawaii, California, Connecticut, New York, Idaho, Virginia, and Washington, DC. They settled in Point Loma in 1984.

Ned is survived by three children, Stephen Kellogg (Ann Lindsey) of Burbank, California, Joyce Fischer Baird (Rodger Baird) of Escondido, California, and Carolyn Kellogg Davis (Jim Davis) of Kingwood, Texas. He is also survived by 11 grandchildren: Thomas and Phoebe Kellogg; Stephanie Fischer Wilhite, Jenn Fischer Price, John Fischer, Mark Fischer, Rory and Nathan Baird; Hope, Joy and Drew Davis and three great-grandchildren.

CDR Robert Lee Harshberger USN (Ret) '58

On Sunday afternoon, September 8, 2013, the curtains of Heaven above Coronado opened and Robert L. Harshberger, Bob, Husband, Dad, friend to anyone in need, barber shopper, car nut, raconteur, was welcomed into the arms of his Mom, Dad and brother Clay. Our world got a little quieter, less bright, but Heaven got a power surge!

Thank you all for your loving prayers and support over the last few months, Bob felt your love every day. Bob was born on 29 July 1934. He was appointed to the US Naval Academy from the state of Pennsylvania in 1953 and graduated four years later with the Class of 58. He served his country for 25 years as a Naval Aviator until his retirement in 1983. Bob was a member of Coronado Knights of Columbus Council 5216, Optimist Club of Coronado, American Legion Post 492 and El Cajon Music Masters. Mass of Resurrection will be held for Bob on Friday, September 20th at 10am at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Coronado, CA. Internment at Fort Rosecrans will follow at a date to be determined.

Bob is survived by his wife, Claudette, four children and six grandchildren, daughters Mary Ellen Harshberger and spouse Bjorn Rafto, Becky Harshberger and spouse David Stevenson, Claudine Niski and spouse Brian Niski and son Bob Harshberger Jr. and grandchildren Tollak, Mars, and Rigel Rafto and Carley, Austin, and Sierra Niski.
