Brendan Looney was killed in action in Afghanistan on Sept. 21, 2010 while assigned to a West Coast-based SEAL team.

Brendan was a 3-time letter winner in lacrosse, a history major, and a member of the 18th Company. He had two younger brothers who also graduated from USNA with the Classes of '06 and '07.

Commissioned as an intelligence officer, he redesignated as a SEAL.

LT Looney will be sorely missed by his colleagues and his many other friends from USNA. His willingness to serve our Nation during a time of conflict serves to remind us all of the Commitment we make to our country as Leaders in the Naval Service.
